




INTRODUCTION




About


You might believe in God. You might not. That's okay. Consider this an experiment to see if God will show up!

Posture

There are a variety of postures people take when they pray. People fold their hands, or raise their hands, or turn their palms upward toward the sky. Men and women close their eyes and bow their heads, or lift their eyes wide open to the heavens. Whatever you feel connects you best with God while praying is okay.



Time

DAY ONE

EXPERIENCING GOD

DAYFIVE

And I pray the Holy Spirit will give me the wisdom to know what your will is for me plus the strength and perseverance to do it.

DAY ELEVEN

Followers of Jesus are called to serve like Jesus served. Find a church with service opportunities or volunteer with an organization you feel passionate about.


